



Terms and Conditions

TASTER SESSIONS

- By booking for a taster session, you acknowledge that participation in gymnastics, like any sport, carries inherent risks.
- British Gymnastics provides insurance coverage for the taster session.
- We recommend that you stay on the premises during your child's taster session.
- Please be aware that parents/carers are not permitted in the hall during the taster session.

SIGN UP PROCEDURE & FEES

- Following the taster session, to continue enrolment, the initial payment includes:
 1. Fee for the remaining classes in the current month
 2. British Gymnastics membership and insurance fee (£22)
 3. Annual Evoke Gymnastics club membership fee (£25)
- After this initial payment you will be required to set up a direct debit with Evoke Gymnastics for monthly payments, in advance, commencing the 1st of the following month.
- Please note that Direct Debits are payable in 12 equal payments covering 48 weeks training. i.e. an annual fee for 48 weeks training divided into 12 equal payments.
- In the event of a session cancellation, we will make every effort to schedule a makeup session. Alternatively, the credited session will be adjusted in the following month.

CANCELLATIONS

- If your child decides not to continue, kindly inform us, and we will cancel your direct debit from the following month.
- Please note that no refunds will be issued for cancelled sessions.

INSURANCE

- Evoke Gymnastics, a British Gymnastics registered club, requires your child to be registered with British Gymnastics for insurance coverage.
- Participation will be declined until the BG Membership Number is provided.

CLOTHING / UNIFORM

- Attire for classes is a leotard and/or t-shirt with shorts. Evoke t-shirts can be purchased at the reception for £16.
- Development and Squad gymnasts will receive specific information regarding their uniform requirements.
- Jewellery removal is mandatory. In the case of new piercings, small studs can be taped for up to 6 weeks.
- Hair must be securely tied back.

GENERAL

- Parents/carers are generally not permitted in the hall during regular classes to maintain a focused learning environment.
- Annually, we organise a club competition where gymnasts have the opportunity to showcase their skills to their families and friends. The date of the club competition will be communicated well in advance
